

HGV DRIVERS OFFENCES

"More convictions were upheld for drivers' hours and tachograph offences in 2013-2014 than in the previous year."

There were a total of **4,050 convictions** in **2013-2014**, up 6% on the previous year. Ms Perry made the announcement when pressed to reveal the number of British and non-UK HGV drivers found to be committing an offence under drivers' hours regulations.

Fixed Penalty Notices





The number of GB registered trucks issued with a fixed penalty notice (FPN) for drivers' hours or tachograph offences rose from 1,972 to **2,022** between 2012-13 and 2013-14.

However, the number of non-GB registered trucks issued with an FPN for drivers' hours or tachograph offences fell to **4,675** from 5,191 in the same period.

Despite the increases in convictions, the total number of trucks checked for drivers' hours offences in DVSA roadside checks actually dropped from 80,796 in 2012-13 to **77,978 in 2013-14**.
